

Main draw teams, FIVB delegates/officials, and Volleyball World Staff will be required to take taxis from the airport to Grand Regency to ensure on-demand transport. These stakeholders will receive a cash reimbursement of USD 40 (USD 20 for arrival and USD 20 for departure) upon receiving your accreditation for the Airport transfer (arrival and departure). This reimbursement covers both the arrival and pre-payment for the departure.

Accreditation

- Accreditation will be required by all athletes, FIVB officials, referees, VW staff, VIPs, media, technical staff, court personnel, volunteers, vendors, etc. by organisers, and will ensure that only those with appropriate accreditation can access the designated venue areas.
- Accreditations shall be picked up at the Official Hotel at the dedicated location from March 2nd.

Catering

- Organiser will provide all three meals for Main Draw athletes, <u>breakfast</u>, <u>lunch</u>, and <u>dinner</u> at the hotel. Meals will be arranged by the organiser from dinner the day before the Main Draw event (March 5) starts until breakfast the day after the team is eliminated from the event. Main Draw players and Hotel guests booked with the organizer will have their meal at the hotel. The LUNCH and DINNER schedule will be posted in the Official Hotel.
- The organizer will provide water, drinks and fruits during the event at the venue.

Medical Services and Procedures

- During Competition & Training
 - During Competition & Training, there will be first responders will be on standby at the venue
 - o During the Competition, an Ambulance will be on call at the venue
 - Doping control may be conducted, therefore, athletes are highly recommended to keep their passports and official IDs of the players with him/her.

- Out of Competition & Training
 - For Out of Competition & Training (March 2nd to 4th), there will be first aid treatment in the Venue if needed.
 - Teams and all participants are requested to follow the hygiene protocol posted by the FIVB Medical Department. It is no longer mandatory to keep the face masks at this time. It is only recommended to wear it at hospitals and on public transportation.
- The hospital will be chosen depending on the injury
 - o Emergency Services Number (Medical & Fire Department): 112
 - Emergency Services Number (Police): 999
- In the case of an emergency, organizer will provide first responders. The cost of treatment will be covered by the athlete concerned.
- Each individual athlete is obliged to have their own insurance as per FIVB Event Regulations Chapter 17.

Mixed Zones and Press Conferences

• Athletes are required to attend mixed zone interviews after each match, while still in competition uniform. The scheduling of press conferences will be communicated to athletes in advance. All athletes are required to attend the press conference(s), if requested.

Uniforms

In preparation for the Volleyball World Beach Pro Tour Elite 16 - Doha, Volleyball World together with the event organisers kindly requests that male and female players respect the local culture and wear the singlet/shorts uniform set. Please be advised that Volleyball World will provide the singlets onsite. - Playing tops/tanks will be provided to all athletes (Main Draw and Qualification) by the organiser. One (1) Uniform (top/tank) will be provided per match day.
- Shorts and accessories are the responsibility of the players and/or their sponsors. If required by the FIVB Technical Delegate, other uniforms and accessories will be checked during the Preliminary Inquiry. Athletes of the same team must wear the same color and style of shorts.

- 4 Training courts will be available, for teams starting March 2nd till March 4th, during the event 2 courts will be available at the event venue. Transportation for training will be provided starting March 2nd, 2024 for all teams staying at the official hotel.
- Please note that for official training at competition courts, from March 2nd, training session reservations can be made no more than 24 hours in advance. Each team is entitled to make one reservation per day (i.e. teams cannot reserve multiple training sessions for the week ahead). Additional training sessions may be possible only if the courts are available.
- Athletes must register in the training booking platform at least 24 hours before the intended training session.
