3. COMPETITION SPECIFIC

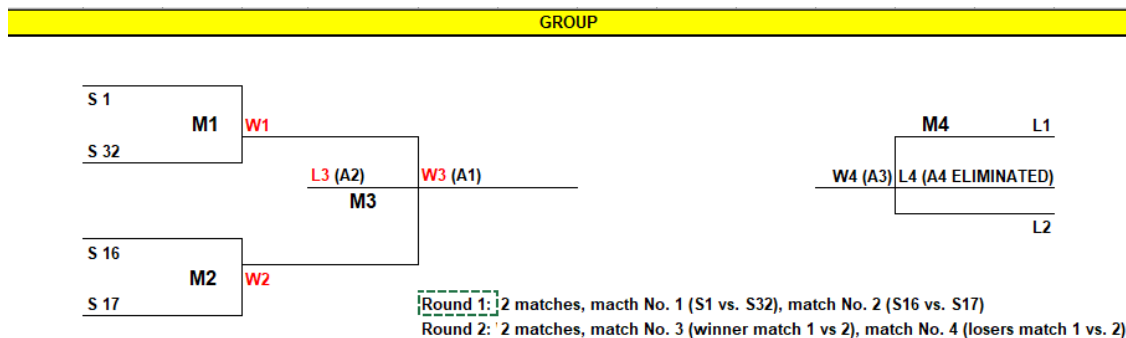
3.1 Competition Format

➤ Qualification Tournament

- Consists of 16 teams playing in single elimination format to qualify 4 teams to the main draw tournament. Qualification tournament of both genders will be played on **16th March 2023**.
- 14 Qualification teams enter directly, together with 2 Qualification wild cards teams (if applicable).
- Country quota: maximum 4 teams per NF excluding wild cards in the tournament of Main Draw and Qualification tournament, with maximum 3 teams directly in the Main Draw for the host teams and maximum 2 teams directly in the Main Draw for the foreign teams. Should the Qualification tournament roster not be full, and no other teams (respecting the country quota of 4 in total) in the reserve team list, the 5th and eventually the 6th host teams placed in the host reserve list will be picked up to fill the roster of Qualification tournament.
- Should the above efforts be explored, and the Qualification tournament is still not full, then any eventual teams (over the total country quota of 4 for foreign teams and 6 for host teams, excluding wild cards) will be picked up to fill the roster, respecting the priority of the teams' entry points.

➤ Main Draw Tournament

- Consists of 16 teams playing in two phases as following:
First phase: four (4) pools of four (4) teams playing modified pool play. Top three (3) teams from each pool will advance to the second phase.
Second phase: knock-out bracket (12 teams) in single elimination format.
- 10 Main Draw teams, together with 2 Main Draw wild cards teams enter directly.
- Country quota: maximum 4 teams per NF excluding wild cards in the tournament of Main Draw and Qualification tournament, with maximum 3 teams directly in the Main Draw for the host teams and maximum 2 teams directly in the Main Draw for the foreign teams.
- For the Pool Phase, matches will be played in the competition format of a modified pool play, i.e. the highest seeded team will play the lowest seeded team in the same pool, while the 2nd highest seeded team will play the 3rd highest seeded team in the same pool. The winners of the above two matches will play each other, with the winner to top the pool and the loser as 2nd ranked team from the pool phase. The losers of the above two matches will play each other, with the winner as the 3rd ranked team from
- Seeding of the host country: the best host country team will be seeded#1 in Pool A if the team is among top 4 seeded teams, otherwise, it will be seeded#4 in Pool D.



- The top four (4) host country teams (as per its seeding points) shall never be placed in the same pool. The 2nd, 3rd and 4th host country team(s) will have their seed increased (for example from Seed #5 to Seed #6) until they are in a different pool than the other top four (4) host country teams. Should increasing the seed not work (or not be possible) then the seed is reduced (for example from Seed #16 to Seed 15) until such host country team is in a different pool. However, for 5th, 6th and any other eventual host country team(s), it is possible to be placed in the same pool with the top four (4) host country teams. The relative seeding of the top 4 host country teams must be respected while this is not applicable for the 5th, 6th and any other eventual host country teams.

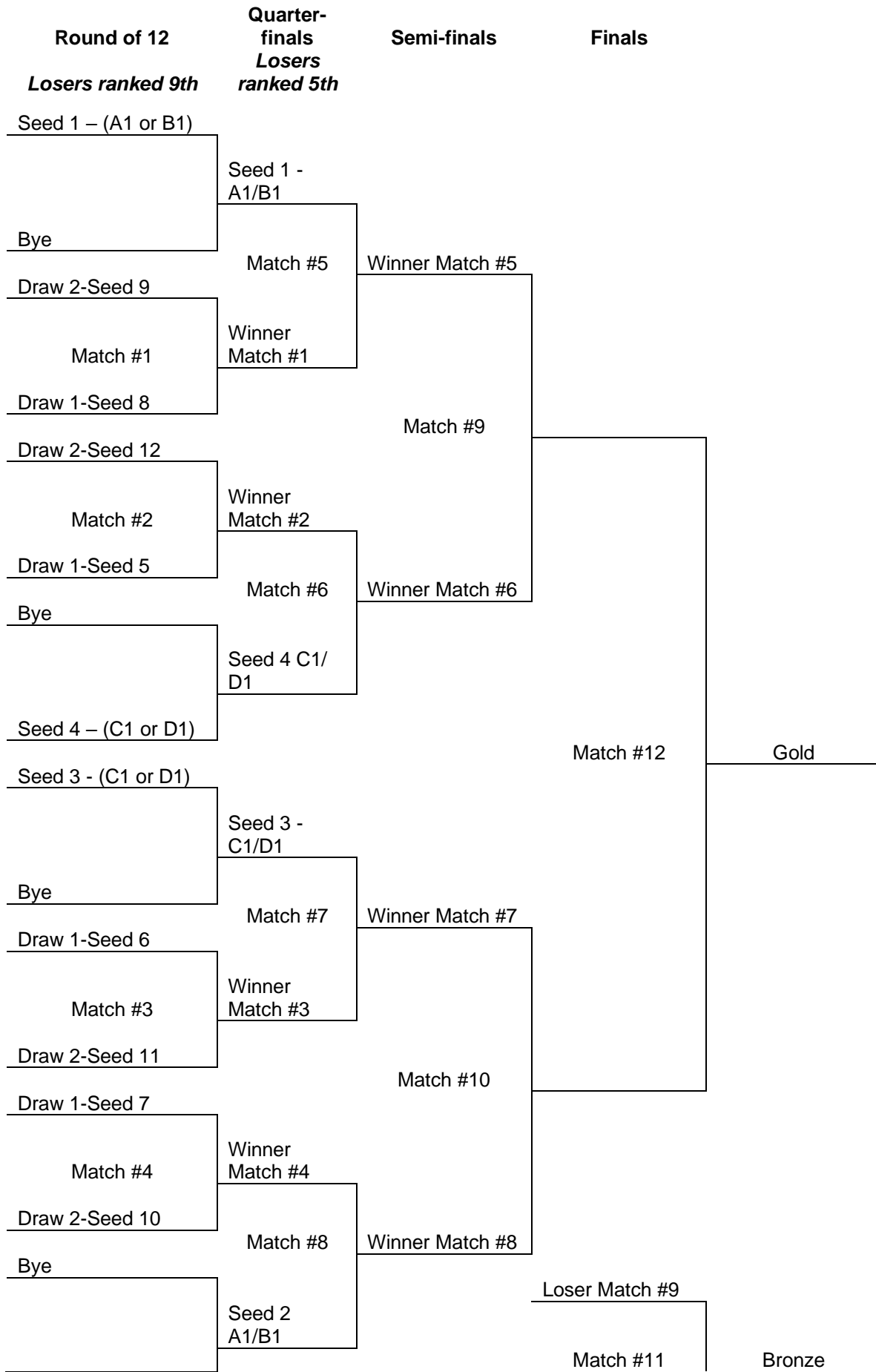
Example: As showed in the below diagram, 8 teams already in the Main Draw from the host country (including wild cards), their seeding positions are AUS 1 (seed #1), AUS 2 (seed #3), AUS 3 (seed #6), AUS 4 (seed #8), AUS 5 (seed #10), AUS 6 (seed #13), AUS 7 (seed #14) and AUS 8 (seed #15)

Based on the above mention regulations, the final seeding will be established as below:

- Top 3 teams in each pool qualify for the 12-team playoff



3.2 Entry and Seeding Points

➤ Confirmed Entry List

- For the Beach Pro Tour Future event, confirmed list is issued 28 days prior to the start of the tournament.
- There is no restriction for top ranked athlete participating in (Mt. Maunganui Beach Futures.
- Country quota: maximum 4 teams per NF excluding wild cards in the tournament of Main Draw and Qualification tournament, with maximum 3 teams directly in the Main Draw for the host teams and maximum 2 teams directly in the Main Draw for the foreign teams. Should the Qualification tournament roster not be full, and no other teams (respecting the country quota of 4 in total) in the reserve team list, the 5th and eventually the 6th host teams placed in the host reserve list will be picked up to fill the roster of Qualification tournament.
- Should the above efforts be explored, and the Qualification tournament is still not full, then any eventual teams (over the total country quota of 4 for foreign teams and 6 for host teams, excluding wild cards) will be picked up to fill the roster, respecting the priority of the teams' entry points.
- For the Beach Pro Tour Futures tournaments, the host country is awarded with minimum three (3) teams per gender in the Main Draw regardless of entry points.
- Regulations of organizer's vacancy will remain in 2023 season:
 - National Federations (NFs) that organize a Volleyball World Beach Pro Tour tournament will be granted one (1) vacancy in each tournament for the corresponding gender in the Qualification tournaments of Challenge/Futures, if no team registered from that country qualifies in such tournament. The vacancy only applies to the same season as indicated below:
 - NFs organizing Elite and Challenge tournament: one (1) vacancy in Qualification tournament for all Challenge tournaments.
 - NFs organizing Future tournament: one (1) vacancy in Qualification tournament for all Future tournaments.
 - The National Federations that already have a team in the tournament will not benefit from the above rule.

➤ Seeding points

For both qualification and main draw tournaments, seeding list will be established one day prior to the start of tournament and will be announced after completion of the preliminary inquiry.

3.3 Drawing of lots after the 1st phase

A drawing of lots will be conducted after the first phase of pool play to place teams in the single elimination bracket.

- For men's tournament, it will be 30 minutes after the last modified pool play match on **17th March**
- For women's tournament, it will be 30 minutes after the last modified pool play match on **17th March**
- Should there be any change on the above schedule, the teams will be updated onsite.

3.4 Match schedule

The detailed match schedule will be published immediately on the Volleyball World website once approved by the FIVB Technical Delegate onsite. It will be no later than 1 hour after the end of last match of day or 1 hour after the seeding list is established after Preliminary Inquiry.

Please note that reservation of training can be made one day in advance **for the next day only** and each team is entitled to **make one reservation per day**. Additional training session may be available only if the courts will be available.

3.8 Uniform and Accessories:

The playing tops/tanks will be provided by the organizer for all Main Draw and Qualification players. Shorts/bottoms and accessories must be provided by the players and/or by their sponsors.

If required by the FIVB Technical Delegate, other uniforms and accessories will be checked during the Preliminary Inquiry. Athletes of the same team must wear the same colour and style of shorts.

Note: The FIVB Beach Volleyball ranking points obtained from the Volleyball World Beach Pro Tour Future tournaments for the host country teams, will only be calculated for entry and seeding purpose if they will be beneficial for the teams (i.e. improve the teams' entry points and seeding).

4.1 Competition Venue

4.2 Arrival and Departure

The official airport confirmed by the organizer is as follows:

Name of the airport: Tauranga Airport (TRG) Domestic airport only. Nearest International Airport is Auckland International Airport (AKL)

Distance from the airport to venue: Distance from Tauranga (TRG) Airport to competition venue 6.0km.

Distance from Auckland (AKL) International Airport: 220km

Recommended means of transport if organiser does not provide it to the players: Rental car, collection from airport. There are no trains to Tauranga from Auckland. Regionals buses go from Auckland International Airport to Tauranga City [New Zealand's #1 National Bus Network](#) | [InterCity®](#)

4.3 Board and Lodging

Recommended hotels if organiser will not provide hotels to the main draw teams. There are plenty of private accommodations (AirBnB; Bachcare or Booking.com options) or apartments through to backpacker options.

4.4 VISA

Athletes (or their National Federations) will be required to apply early enough for their entry visas, whenever needed and will be accountable for all visa expenses.

Organizers will provide all Organizing Committee members, FIVB Officials, referees, athletes, VIPs, journalists, technical staff, court personnel, volunteers, etc. with an official accreditation card and will ensure that only people with appropriate accreditation will access the designated venue areas.
