



CEV Qualification System To the 2025 FIVB Beach Volleyball World Championships

1. Max Total Quota from CEV Qualification Pathway

Men: 4 teams (8 athletes)

Women: 4 teams (8 athletes)

2. Type of allocation of Quota places

- 2.1 The three (3) quota places qualified through qualification pathway 4.1 are allocated to the team.
- 2.2 The one (1) quota place qualified through qualification pathway 4.2 is allocated to the National Federation.

3. Athlete Eligibility

- 3.1 Each participating athlete must comply with the criteria set forth in 3. Athletes Eligibility of circulated Qualification System document (<u>link</u>).
- 3.2 There are no additional CEV eligibility criteria.

4. Qualification Pathway

- 4.1 Three (3) spots per gender to the top three (3) medal winning teams of Eurobeachvolley 2025.
 - In case these medal winning teams feature amongst the 25 teams qualified to the World Championships though the event specific Ranking Points on 6th October 2025 or country quota/eligibility criteria as set in the 2025 Beach Volleyball World Championships Qualification System document are not met, spot(s) will be allocated to the highest ranked European teams not yet qualified to the World Championships through the ranking on 6th October 2025, respecting country quota and eligibility parameters.
- 4.2 One (1) spot per gender to the winning NF of the CEV Beach Volley Nations Cup Final. The CEV will be presenting this team to the FIVB by September 22nd

in line with the timeline shared in the circulated Qualification System document (link) and respecting the country quota and eligibility criteria as detailed in the respective section of the 2025 FIVB Beach Volleyball World Championships Qualification System document. In case these criteria are not met the spot will be allocated to the highest ranked European NF not qualified to the World Championships through the event specific Ranking Points on 6th October 2025, again respecting country quota and eligibility parameters.

CSV Qualification System To the 2025 FIVB Beach Volleyball World Championships

1. Max Total Quota from CSV Qualification Pathway

Men: 4 teams (8 athletes)

Women: 4 teams (8 athletes)

2. Type of allocation of Quota places

- 2.1 The quota place is allocated to the National Federation (NF).
- 2.2 Each NF must choose its athletes respecting the criteria set by FIVB. Athletes Eligibility.
- 2.3 Only one (1) team per NF can qualify by the CSV ranking.

3. Athlete Eligibility

- 3.1 Each participating athlete must comply with the criteria set forth in 3. Athletes Eligibility of circulated Qualification System document (<u>link</u>).
- 3.2 There are no additional CSV eligibility criteria.

4. Qualification Pathway

- 4.1 CSV Qualification period will be all the 2024/2025 season until CSV Continental Tour Finals (Continental Championship) which is scheduled on 16-18 of May 2025.
- 4.2 The four (4) highest ranked National Federations per gender, based on the sum of all 2024 and 2025 season events (the lowest ranking points from each season will be discarded) will qualify to the 2025 FIVB Beach Volleyball World Championships, respecting the maximum number of quota places per NF per gender and the provisions established by the FIVB and CSV.
- 4.3 The CSV Continental Tour National Federation Rankings are based on the cumulative total of the CSV NF points earned at CSV Continental Tour events. CSV NF points are awarded to the highest finishing NF team at each CSV Beach Tour event.

4.4 Players qualified from FIVB pathway will not be able to add points for their country in the CSV ranking, these points will switch (points earned from another NF team) or dropped if no other team played on same event.

AVC Qualification System To the 2025 FIVB Beach Volleyball World Championships

1. Max Total Quota from AVC Qualification Pathway

Men: 4 teams (8 athletes)

Women: 4 teams (8 athletes)

2. Type of allocation of Quota places

The quota place is allocated to the National Federation (NF). Each NF must choose its athletes respecting the criteria set forth in 3. Athletes Eligibility

3. Athlete Eligibility

- 3.1 Each participating athlete must comply with the criteria set forth in 3. Athletes Eligibility of circulated Qualification System document (<u>link</u>).
- 3.2 There are no additional AVC eligibility criteria.

4. Qualification Pathway

4.1 AVC Qualification period will be from **6th October 2024 to 5th October 2025**. All Beach Pro Tour tournaments within the above-mentioned period, plus all below AVC homologated tournaments will be included in the AVC Qualification process:

- 2024 Asian Senior Beach Volleyball Championships (DG) 5-10 November 2024
- 2025 2nd AVC Beach Tour Nuvali Open (DG) 2-5 April 2025
- 2025 24th AVC Beach Tour Samila Open (DG) 13-16 April 2025
- 2025 AVC Beach Tour Phu Yen Open (W) 25-28 April 2025
- 2025 AVC Beach Tour Doha Open (M) 30 April-3 May 2025
- 2025 AVC Beach Tour Pingtan Open (DG) 8-11 May 2025
- 2025 AVC Beach Tour Pingtung Open (DG) 17-20 July 2025

4.2 The four (4) highest ranks per gender as per the above-mentioned AVC Beach Volleyball NF Ranking will be used for qualifying for the 2025 FIVB Beach Volleyball World Championships, respecting the maximum number of quota places per NF per gender and the provisions established in the 2025 FIVB Beach Volleyball World Championships Qualification System document.

4.3 The calculation of AVC Beach Volleyball National Federation Ranking are as follows:

- The top four (4) ranking points results from the AVC tournaments mentioned above in 4.1, will be counted towards the calculation of the AVC National Federation Ranking. Then the top four (4) ranking points results at Beach Pro Tour tournaments above-mentioned in 4.1, will be added to the total to be calculated to establish the eventual AVC Beach Volleyball NF Ranking.
- The ranking points of the best two (2) teams from each NF per gender from each of tournaments above-mentioned in 4.1, will be counted towards the calculation of the AVC Beach Volleyball NF Ranking.
- The ranking points earned with the best result will be labelled as NF 1 finish and second-best result will be labelled as NF 2 finish.
- The sum of all NF 1 ranking points obtained in the top four (4) finishes at AVC tournaments plus the top four (4) finishes at the Beach Pro Tour tournaments within the above-mentioned period in 4.1, that the NF concerned participated will be the final ranking points of NF 1, regardless of the different players' composition of the team in each tournament, but not including result obtained by an athlete that has qualified to the 2025 FIVB Beach Volleyball World Championships through FIVB Entry Ranking of 5th October 2025.
- The sum of all NF 2ranking points obtained in the top four (4) finishes at AVC tournaments plus the top four (4) finishes at the Beach Pro Tour tournaments within the above-mentioned period in 4.1, that the NF 2 concerned participated will be the final ranking points of NF 2, regardless of the different players' composition of the team in each tournament, but not including result obtained by an athlete that has qualified to the 2025 FIVB Beach Volleyball World Championships through FIVB Entry Ranking of 5th October 2025.
- There will be a maximum of 2 ranks from the same NF per gender in the AVC Volleyball NF Ranking. Accordingly, it is possible to have 2 ranks from the same NF per gender among the four (4) highest ranks in the AVC Qualification pathway. However, if an NF qualifies a team through the FIVB Entry Ranking of 5th October 2025, any results of both athletes of such team will not be used for calculation of AVC Beach Volleyball NF Ranking, and the next highest result of the team from the concerned NF will be picked up for the calculation accordingly.
- In the case there is a tie in the AVC Beach Volleyball NF Ranking, the tie will be broken firstly by the best result obtained by the NF in 2024 Asian Beach Volleyball Championships; and there is still a tie, then the NF with highest points obtained from all tournaments above-mentioned in 4.1 will rank higher;

and if there is still a tie, a drawing of lots will be conducted by the AVC to break the tie as the last resort.

NORCECA Qualification System To the 2025 FIVB Beach Volleyball World Championships

1. Max Total Quota from NORCECA Qualification Pathway

Men: 4 teams (8 athletes)

Women: 4 teams (8 athletes)

2. Type of allocation of Quota places

The quota place is allocated to the National Federation (NF).

3. Athlete Eligibility

- 3.3 Each participating athlete must comply with the criteria set forth in 3. Athletes Eligibility of circulated Qualification System document (<u>link</u>).
- 3.4 There are no additional NORCECA eligibility criteria.

4. Qualification Pathway

4.1 The NORCECA will host NORCECA Beach Volleyball Qualification Tournament(s) to the 2025 FIVB Beach Volleyball World Championships (dates and location TBD). This tournament will decide the four (4) quota places per gender from NORCECA qualification pathway. Such a Qualification tournament will be divided into two (2) pools of six (6) teams per gender and the top two (2) winners of each pool will be awarded the quota place for the 2025 FIVB Beach Volleyball World Championships, provided that their NF has not yet obtained the maximum quota places.

The date and host city (or cities) of each pool in each gender will be confirmed by the NORCECA in due time once finalized. Depending on the eventual confirmation, such Qualification Tournament(s) may be held in four (4) venues, two (2) venues or one (1) venue.

4.2 Each National Federation is allowed to register one (1) team per gender to the above-mentioned Qualification Tournament, and the registration is open to

- top twelve (12) National Federation as of NORCECA Beach Volleyball NF Ranking. (**Details refer to Appendix 1**).
- 4.3 In the case that any National Federation eligible per 4.2 declines its participation, the next eligible National Federation as per NORCECA Beach Volleyball NF Ranking (appendix 1) will be picked up.
- 4.4 Should the NF from the top two (2) of any pool of the Qualification Tournament obtain the full quota place through the FIVB Entry Ranking of 6th October 2025, such quota place from NORCECA Qualification Tournament will be reallocated to the next best ranked National Federation of the abovementioned qualification tournament.
- 4.5 Should one or more of the above qualified National Federations decide not to use the quota place obtained from the NORCECA qualification pathway to the 2025 FIVB Beach Volleyball World Championships, the quota place(s) will be then reallocated to the next best ranked eligible team/NF (i.e. 5th, 6th 7th and 8th, etc. as per the final ranking of the above-mentioned tournament. After all above efforts are explored, upon consideration of NORCECA and upon approval of the FIVB, the other National Federation qualified through NORCECA qualification pathway can use the quota place(s) until fulfilling the maximum quota place (i.e. four (4) per National Federation) if needed. In any case, NORCECA will use the entire quota place of 4 vacancies per gender.

2. Type of allocation of Quota places

The quota place is allocated to the National Federation (NF).

3. Athlete Eligibility

- 3.5 Each participating athlete must comply with the criteria set forth in 3. Athletes Eligibility of circulated Qualification System document (<u>link</u>).
- 3.6 There are no additional CAVB eligibility criteria.

4. Qualification Pathway

4.1 CAVB will host the 2025 CAVB Continental Cup (date and location TBD) which will be used as the CAVB qualifiers for the FIVB 2025 Beach Volleyball World. This tournament will decide the 4 (four) quota places per gender from CAVB qualification pathway.

Note: CAVB is now in negotiations with several National Federations to confirm the date and host city of this tournament, which will be held within the timeline required as per the circulated Qualification System document (<u>link</u>). The date and host city of said tournament will be communicated by CAVB to its affiliated National Federations in due time as it is confirmed.

4.2 the 2025 CAVB Continental Cup will be a team competition, with a quota of maximum 2 (two) teams per gender for participating NFs and a quota of maximum 3 (three) teams per gender for the host country.
