The detailed match schedule will be published immediately on the FIVB website once approved by the FIVB Technical Delegate onsite. It will be no later than 1 hour after the end of last match of the day or 1 hour after the seeding list is established after Preliminary Inquiry.

Competition Format:

Qualification Tournament: 1 day single elimination with a maximum of 24 teams to qualify 4 teams and to fill any vacancy (ies) in the Main Draw due to withdrawals of Main Draw teams.

Main Draw: Thirty-two (32) teams – MAIN DRAW playing in 8 pools of 4 teams in each pool (Round Robin system). The best 3 ranked teams in each pool (a total of 24 teams) will advance to the next phase of Single Elimination.

Twenty four (24) teams will proceed to the single elimination phase which will be played until the bronze and gold medal matches.

2.7 Uniform and Accessories:

The playing tops/tanks will be provided by the organizer for all Main Draw and Qualification players. Shorts/bottoms and accessories must be provided by the players and/or by their sponsors.

2.8 Rules of the Game:

FIVB Official Beach Volleyball Rules (effective at the times of competition) will be applied for the Age Group World Championships.

2.9 Coaching:

Accredited coaches must remain seated in the designated team seating area during play. Coaches may interact with and instruct players during official warm-up, time-outs, technical time-outs, set intervals, court switches, intervals between rallies, and exceptional game interruptions, provided that match flow is not delayed.

Coaches must be present with their team for the entire duration of the match, unless prevented by force majeure (e.g. illness or injury). In such cases, the coach's accreditation remains at the score table, and the coach must be accompanied by an official.

All other applicable FIVB regulations regarding coaching from outside the playing area remain in force.

For a coach to be on the Field of Play, they must be registered on VIS and be added to the team in the event.

3. GENERAL MATTERS

3.1 VISA

Athletes (or their National Federation) will be required to apply early enough for their entry visas (latest 30 days before the event), whenever needed and will be accountable for all visa expenses.

It takes approximately 5 days to issue the Invitation Letter. Information required for invitation letter:

- Country of passport
- Passport number
- Current country of residence
- Date of birth
- Full name (as in passport)
- Gender
- Email/Phone number
- Role at event (i.e. Athlete, Coach, Official)
- Embassy that the VISA will be issued

3.2 ACCREDITATION

Organizers shall provide official accreditation to all relevant participants and personnel, including FIVB officials, referees, athletes, team staff (maximum three accreditations per team), VIPs, media, volunteers, and court personnel, and ensure access is restricted to designated areas accordingly. 3.3 TRANSPORTATION

3.4 ACCOMMODATION

The organizers will provide the **Main Draw teams** with hotel accommodation (**double room**) in the Organizer's designated hotel and with meals from the evening before the start of the Main Draw until the day after the elimination of the teams from the event, breakfast included.

3.5 MEDICAL SERVICES AND PROCEDURES

During Competition & Training

During competition & training, first responders with an ambulance will be on standby at the venue. **There is no ambulance on site, due to the statutory response times in the Netherlands, which fall within the required standards.**

- Doping control may be conducted, therefore, athletes are highly recommended to keep their passports and official IDs on their person.
- The FIVB reserves the right to perform random medical controls on the participating athletes and alcohol tests on the officials, as per FIVB rules and regulations.

Out of Competition & Training

- While out of competition & training, first aid treatment will be possible at the hotel. If more treatment is necessary, the Local Organiser will provide transport to an external facility (if required).
- The choice of hospital will be determined based on the severity of the injury.

Emergency Services Number: **112**

In the case of an emergency, the Local Organiser will provide medical first responders and transportation to the hospital and back. The cost of treatment will be covered by the athlete concerned.

Each individual athlete is obliged to have their own insurance. **Athletes must confirm their insurance company to the LOC during the preliminary inquiry.**

3.6 Mixed and press conferences

Athletes are required to attend mixed zone interviews after each match, while still in competition uniform. The scheduling of press conferences will be communicated to athletes in advance. All athletes are required to attend the press conference(s), if requested.

1. Teams must arrive on time for their scheduled session.
2. Players should wear their official National Team apparel.
3. Players should arrive camera-ready, as no hair or make-up services will be available on site.
4. Each team will be photographed in:
 - Two (2) team poses
 - Two (2) individual poses per player
 - Six (6) poses in total per team
5. The photoshoot will last **no longer than five (5) minutes per team**.
