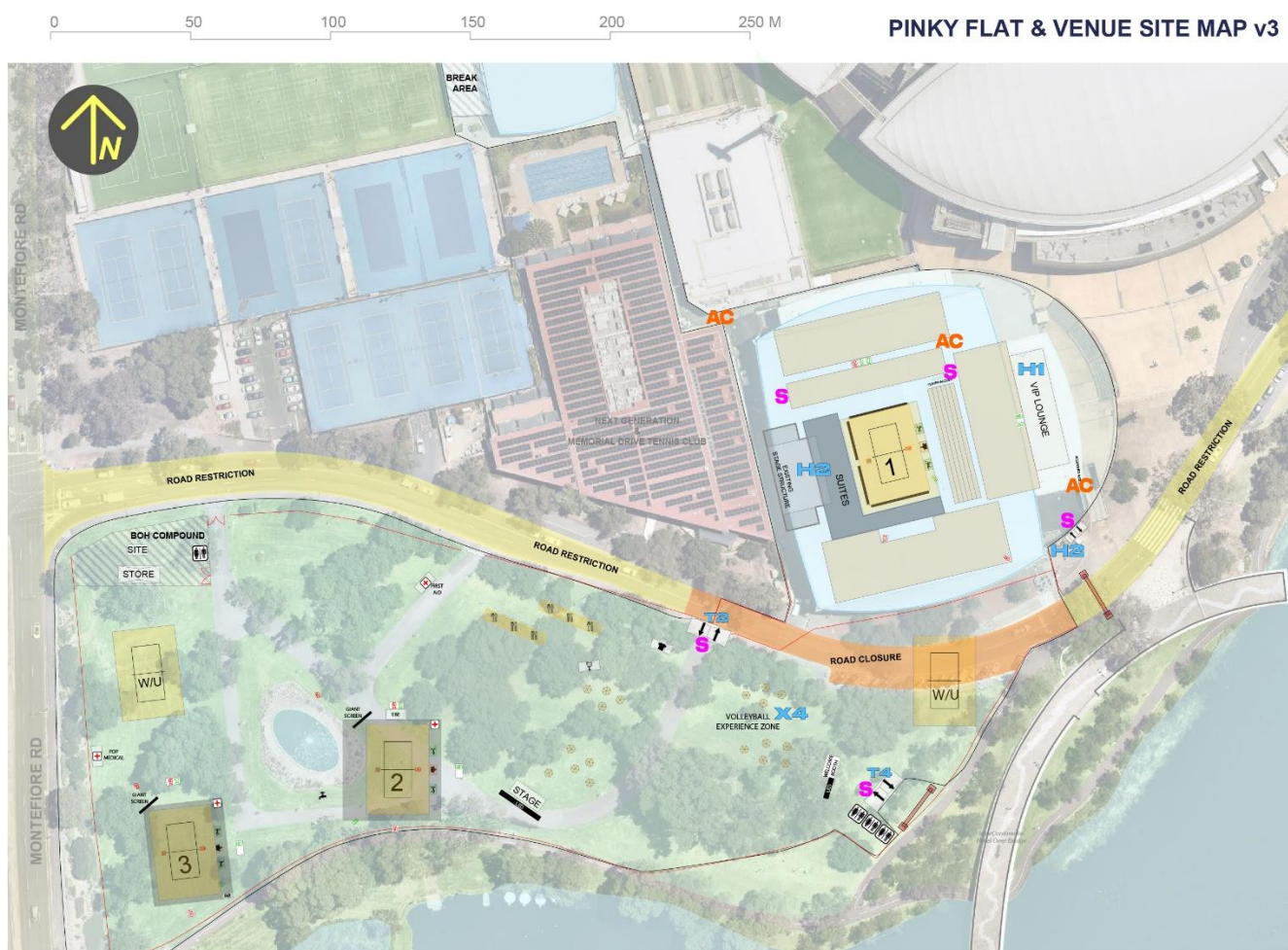

## Transportation

- The official airport confirmed by the organiser is as follows:

### Accreditation

- Accreditation will be required by all athletes, FIVB officials, referees, VW staff, VIPs, media, technical staff, court personnel, volunteers, vendors, etc. by organisers, and will ensure that only those with appropriate accreditation can access the designated venue areas.

### Catering

- Organiser will provide all three meals for athletes and referees. Meals will be arranged by the organiser from dinner the day before the event starts until breakfast the day after the team was eliminated from the event.
- Breakfasts will be served at the official hotel each day.
- Officials will have their **lunches and dinners provided at the catering room at the venue.**

### Ticketing

- Tickets to centre court are now available for purchase. Ground passes which will provide access to courts 2 and 3 will go on sale in August 2025 via the same links as below.
- Teams will be provided with 2 tickets per player for friends and family to be used from the Quarter finals onward.

### Medical Services and Procedures

- During Competition & Training
  - During Competition & Training, there will be a first responders at the competition venue
  - Doping control may be conducted, therefore, athletes are highly recommended to keep their passports and official ids of the players with them.
- Out of Competition & Training
  - For Out of Competition & Training there will be the option to arrange a first aid treatment in the hotel. If more treatment is necessary, local organiser will provide a transportation where needed.
  - Teams and all participants are requested to follow the hygiene protocol posted by the FIVB Medical Department. It is no longer mandatory to keep the face masks at this time. It is only recommended to wear it at hospitals and in public transportations.

- In the case of an emergency, organiser will provide first responders and transportation all the way to the hospital and back. The cost of treatment will be covered by the athlete concerned.
- Each individual athlete is obliged to have their own insurance as per FIVB Event Regulations – Chapter 17.

### Mixed Zones and Press Conferences

- Athletes are required to attend mixed zone interviews after each match, while still in competition uniform. The scheduling of press conferences will be communicated to athletes in advance. All athletes are required to attend the press conference(s), if requested.

### Uniforms

- As per the [Uniform Guidelines](#) published on the event website and the 2025 Beach World Champs. National Federations and teams will have the opportunity of producing their own playing uniforms. Teams that won't be able to produce their uniforms must inform the LOC, considering the deadlines on the Uniform Guidelines. Shorts/bottoms and accessories are responsibility of the players and/or their sponsors. The FIVB Technical Delegate will validate other uniforms and accessories during the Preliminary Inquiry. Athletes of the same team must wear the same colour of shorts.

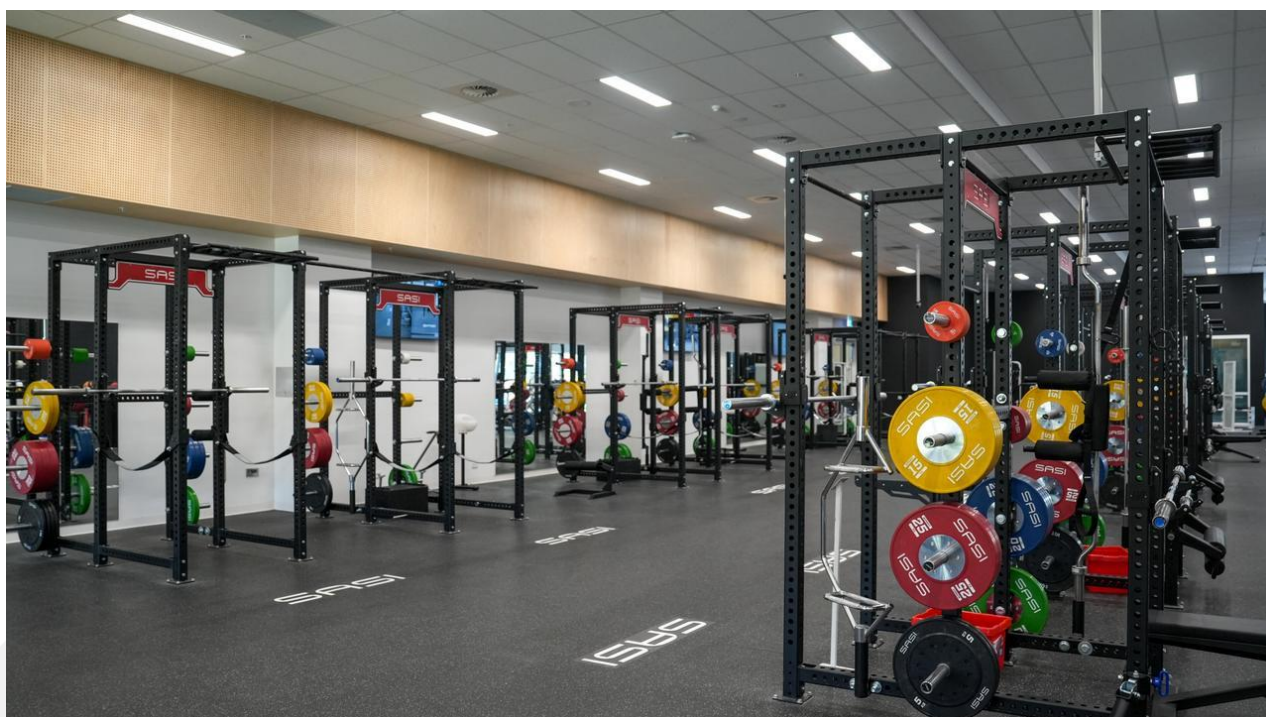

### 3. Competition

#### Preliminary Inquiry Requirements & Schedule

- Attendance to the Preliminary Enquiry and Technical Meeting (if required) is mandatory for both team athletes. **Athletes must bring their uniform, including any headgear, armbands or other pieces of uniform intended to be used during matches for approval of the Technical Delegate.** The detailed schedule is as follows:

## Training

- **Please note that official training starts as from the 9th November.** Training session reservations can be made no more than 24 hours in advance. Each team is entitled to make one reservation per day (i.e. teams cannot reserve multiple training sessions for the week ahead). Additional training sessions may be possible only if the courts are available.
- Athletes must **register in the training booking platform by at least 24 hours before** the intended training session.
- The **familiarisation training will be arranged by the FIVB/Volleyball World**, together with the local organiser, depending on the arrival of participating teams to the tournament. **Teams arriving on or before 11 November will benefit from the familiarisation training**, provided that teams submit to the organiser their arriving information in due time. The schedule will be published after the drawing of lots of pool phase.
