Athlete Uniform Guidelines

Introduction

This document will provide guidance to participating teams vis-a-vis the authorised identifications, layout and submission of athlete uniforms for the 2025 Beach World Championships. Please direct any questions to uniforms@volleyball.world.

Submission and Approval Process

For host country teams and teams qualifying through the entry ranking, uniform layouts must be submitted by **1**st **of October 2025.** National Federations are requested to submit the digital layout of the uniforms (in all three colours) featuring all branding elements via THIS LINK.

For teams qualifying through the Continental Qualification pathway, layouts must be submitted latest by **1**st **of October 2025**, via <u>THIS LINK</u>.

A final check of uniforms and equipment for all 48 men's and women's teams will take place during the Preliminary Inquiries (11th, 12th and 13th of November 2025) before the start of the Beach Volleyball World Championships. Detailed instructions on the onsite uniform check and sponsor printing process will be circulated closer to the event.

If a National Federation is not in a position to provide their athletes with a uniform for the 2025 Beach Volleyball World Championships, please send an email to uniforms@volleyball.world by 1st of August 2025, confirming also if tops or singlets are to be used.

- Confirmed Entry List date: 6th of October 2025
- Uniforms submission deadline (Host / Entry Ranking): 1st of October 2025
- Uniforms submission deadline (Continental Qualification): 1st of October 2025
- Submission process: please upload the digital layout of your uniforms via THIS LINK.
- Sample check: at Preliminary Inquiry (11th, 12th and 13th of November 2025)
- Uniform support deadline: 1st of August 2025




Women's top

- Each team must provide 3 sets of uniforms in contrasting colours.
- At least 2 sets of uniforms must match your country colours.
- The uniforms may feature unique, country-specific designs.

• Front:

- Country Code to be positioned on left upper-chest. Max. size 4cm (height) x 10cm (width).
- o **Number** to be positioned on right upper-chest. Max. size 4cm (height) x 2.5cm (width).
- Manufacturer (if applicable) to be positioned on right upper-chest, above player number. Size must not
 exceed 30cm².
- Sponsor A: Area reserved for Event Sponsor. Dimensions: 3.3cm (height) x 15.5cm (width).
- Back (in order from top to bottom):
 - O Number Max. size 4cm (height) x 2.5cm (width)
 - Country code Max. size 3cm (height) x 7.5cm (width)
 - Athlete Name (as illustrated below).
 - O Sponsor B: Area reserved for Volleyball World sponsor. Dimensions to be provided.
- The use of **Druk Wide Medium** font is mandatory. <u>Download here.</u>
- Font colour must be either **black** or **white**.
- 3-letter country code is recommended. Exceptions must be raised to FIVB (details on p.5).



Female players may choose from various playing top styles, including singlets, tops, and others. While it is strongly recommended that all team members wear the same style during matches, exceptions may be made when uniformity is not feasible for a particular match. In such cases, all tops—regardless of style—must feature identical patterns, colours, and team identifiers to maintain visual consistency.




Women's singlet

- Each team must provide 3 sets of uniforms in contrasting colours.
- At least 2 sets of uniforms must match your country colours.
- The uniforms may feature unique, country-specific designs.

• Front:

- o Country Code to be positioned on left upper-chest. Max. size 8cm (height) x 20cm (width).
- O **Number** to be positioned on right upper-chest. Max. size 8cm (height) x 6cm (width).
- Manufacturer (if applicable) to be positioned on right upper-chest, above player number. Size must not exceed 30cm².
- Sponsor A: Area reserved for Event Sponsor. Dimensions: 19.5cm (height) x 30cm (width).
- Back (in order from top to bottom):
 - Number Max. size 8cm (height) x 6cm (width)
 - Country code Max. size 8cm (height) x 20cm (width)
 - Athlete Name (as illustrated below).
 - Sponsor B: Area reserved for Volleyball World sponsor. Dimensions to be provided.
- The use of **Druk Wide Medium** font is mandatory. <u>Download here.</u>
- Font colour must be either black or white.
- 3-letter country code is recommended. Exceptions must be raised to FIVB (details on p.5).






Men's top

- Each team must provide 3 sets of uniforms in contrasting colours.
- At least 2 sets of uniforms must match your country colours.
- The uniforms may feature unique, country-specific designs.

Front:

- Country Code to be positioned on left upper-chest. Max. size 8cm (height) x 20cm (width).
- o **Number** to be positioned on right upper-chest. Max. size 8cm (height) x 6cm (width).
- Manufacturer (if applicable) to be positioned on right upper-chest, above player number. Size must not
 exceed 30cm².
- Sponsor A: Area reserved for Event Sponsor. Dimensions: 19.5cm (height) x 30cm (width).
- Back (in order from top to bottom):
 - O Number Max. size 8cm (height) x 6cm (width)
 - Country code Max. size 8cm (height) x 20cm (width)
 - Athlete Name (as illustrated below).
 - Sponsor B: Area reserved for Volleyball World sponsor. Dimensions to be provided.
- The use of **Druk Wide Medium** font is mandatory. <u>Download here.</u>
- Font colour must be either **black** or **white**.
- 3-letter country code is recommended. Exceptions must be raised to FIVB (details on p.5).



In the case that a player uses a different uniform type (for religious, cultural or other reasons), the criteria regarding placement of identifications will remain the same as above.



Third Party Identification

Athlete Name

The athlete name (i.e. last name or nickname - if the latter is authorised by the FIVB) must be included at the back of the athlete's uniform, below the country code, in a colour contrasting with that of the playing uniform. Player names on the uniform must match exactly with the information on the VIS player profile, with the exception of special characters.

Letters must be between 2cm and 3cm high for crop tops and between 4cm and 6cm high for singlets, depending on the total number of letters in the athlete's name. The use of "Druk Wide Medium" font is mandatory. Download here.

Women Top

- From 2 to 5 letters: 3cm high with a character strip at least 0.6cm wide.
- From 6 to 9 letters: 2.5cm high with a character strip at least 0.5cm wide.
- 10 letters and above: 2cm high with a character strip at least 0.4cm wide.

Men Top

- From 2 to 5 letters: 6cm high with a character strip at least 1.2cm wide.
- From 6 to 9 letters: 5cm high with a character strip at least 1cm wide.
- 10 letters and above: 4cm high with a character strip at least 0.8cm wide.

Numbers

The athlete's number (#1 or #2) must be printed on the front and back of the athlete uniform with a maximum size of:

Women Top

4cm (height) x 2.5cm (width) with a character strip at least 0.8cm wide.

Men Top

• 8cm (height) x 6cm (width) with a character strip at least 1.6cm wide.

When registering teams for the 2025 Beach Volleyball World Championships, National Federations must ensure that the correct player numbers are used.



National Identity

The country code must be printed, embroidered, or woven at the **front and back** of the uniform on a maximum total surface of:

Women Top

- 4cm (height) x 10cm (width) on the **front** with a character strip at least 0.8cm wide.
- 3cm (height) x 7.5cm (width) on the **back** with a character strip at least 0.6cm wide.

Men Top

8cm (height) x 20cm (width) on the front and back with a character strip at least 1.6cm wide.

FIVB recommends a 3-letter country code. In case a team wishes to use the full country name, it must submit a design to FIVB in advance. FIVB will examine the design and approve it only if the full name is appropriately displayed in the above sizes.

Sponsor Logos

Sponsor logos are reserved for the Event Sponsor and Volleyball World - on the front and back of the uniform - respectively. Teams are requested to integrate these logos to their uniform design and submit a to-scale, digital mock-up for approval. The required logo dimensions are listed above in the "Crop Top" and "Singlet" sections.

Download Sponsor Logo Print Files

- Event Sponsor logo (front of uniform): <u>Download here (logo will be confirmed by 1st of August)</u>
- Volleyball World Sponsor logo (back of uniform): <u>Download here</u> (logo will be confirmed by 1st of August)
- If you would like to submit the uniforms design prior to sponsor confirmation, you are required to submit it with the front and back sponsors space free of any logos.

Shorts / Bottoms & Accessories

Athletes must use their own shorts / bottoms and accessories. There are no specific design guidelines for these pieces and - like Beach Pro Tour events - athletes have the opportunity to utilise them for sponsor exposure.
