SAMPLE DROP OFF/SUBMISSION

Beach Volleyball Requirements:

- Submission time by NOC CLO is fixed daily at 09:00 or at 18:00.
- **09:00 Submission:** For those beach volleyball athletes playing in the morning session, it is required that to submit your samples before 09:00 the day before your scheduled match.

Example: Team A plays at 10:00 on 24 July 2021 must drop off/submit the sample by 09:00 on 23 July 2021.

Result will be delivered latest by 21:00 on 23 July 2021.

SAMPLE DROP OFF/SUBMISSION

Beach Volleyball Requirements:

- **18:00 Submission:** For those athletes playing in the afternoon and evening sessions, it is required to submit your samples before 18:00 the day before your scheduled match.

Example: Team A plays at 15:00 on 24 July 2021 must drop off/submit their sample by 18:00 on 23 July 2021.

Result will be delivered latest by 06:00 on 24 July 2021.

RESULT DELIVERY

As per The Playbook for the athletes and team officials:

- You will be given a deadline by which your test result will be delivered. Process is expected to take 12 hours.
- If you do not receive a notification from your CLO by the designated time, your result was negative.

Example: You submitted your test at 08:30 (i.e. before 09:00) on 23 July 2021 and did not receive any notification by 21:00 on 23 July 2021. This means that your test result is negative.

- If result of your Saliva PCR test is unclear or positive, your CLO will see a notification and inform you.

Example: You submitted your test at 08:30 on 23 July 2021 and were contacted by your CLO at 15:00 about an unclear or positive result. Please follow your CLO instructions.
